

Illinois Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Illinois account for 13.36 percent of the total output in the state, employing 9.69 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$99.67 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 573,700 manufacturing employees in Illinois in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$78,971 in 2013.

Figure 1: Illinois Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

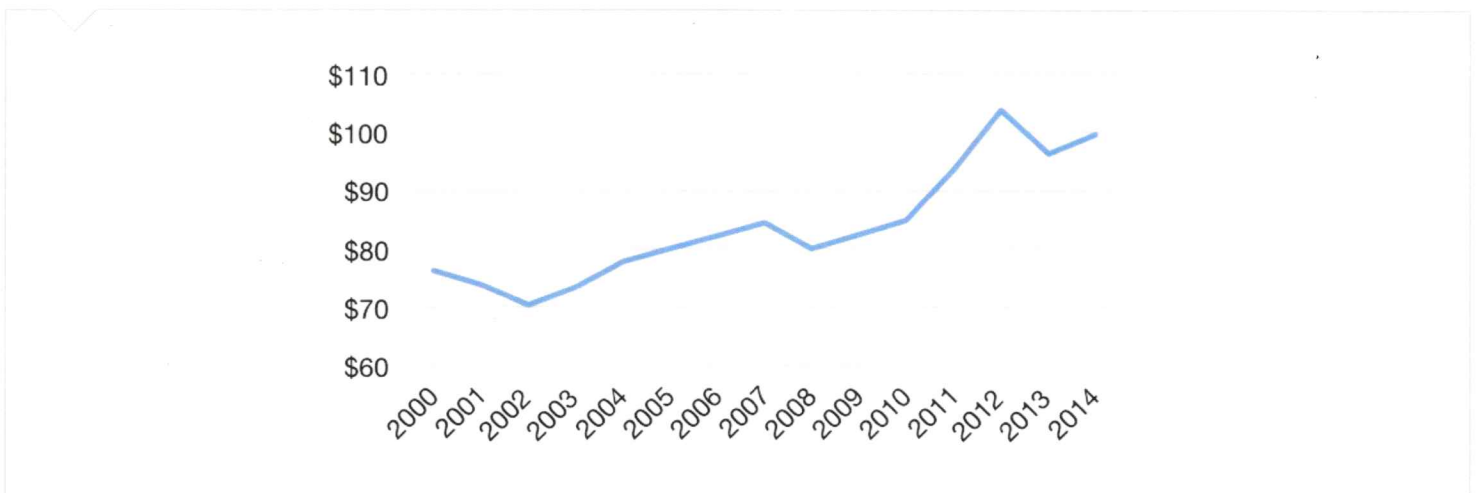


Figure 2: Top 10 Illinois Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013
